Earl's 1st Amendment Grill provides food, clothes and essentials to Protesters and the Community members. Earl's was started as an immediate reaction to the outcry for support from citizens protesting the deaths of Breyonna Taylor, George Floyd, DeOnté Rawlings, and many others.

As the Earls Community grew in size and closeness we came in contact with the reality that many of our supports, volunteers and guest were facing immediate housing and economic crisis. As we noticed a demand from a growing population of homeless citizens our leader Reginald Guy Decided to encourage the earl community to start and operate a non-profit that meets the needs of the people.

What Has Earl's Done This Month?

- We proudly partnered with [The Palm Collective](#), [Until Freedom DC](#), [The Live Movement](#) and [Freedom Fighters DC](#) to organize a community "Friendsgiving" food and clothing drive at Thomas Circle, Adams Morgan, Columbia heights and K street bridge homeless encampment.
- We grilled for DC Bike Party demonstrators at Dupont Circle to help fuel their monthly ride.
- In collaboration with Hayden's liquor store we have established a weekly venue for community fundraising and clothing at this location we also will continue providing free food, water, and feminine hygiene products .
- We grilled for voters and poll workers for early voting and on election day
- We provided food for U street citizens attending the opening day of the U street community park meet and greet with local ANC Candidates.
- We executed a month long "Free Boutique and Clothing Drive" residency at the [sPACyCLOUD lounge](#) in collaboration with [DCHAS](#) to shine a light on local artists and activists. The residency was a great success and the art auction was able to raise thousands of dollars for legal assistance for DC protesters.
- We partnered with Adams Morgan community activist Mr.Pascal to organize a winter coat drive at SunTrust Plaza on Columbia Road.
- At Black Lives Matter Plaza, and the Department of Education, Supreme Court, AFL-CIO, and other locations we fed activists and protesters participating in the Art-In and tent city occupations organized by [The Palm Collective](#) and [The Live Movement](#).

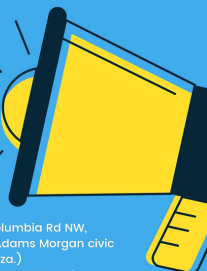

Action Plans

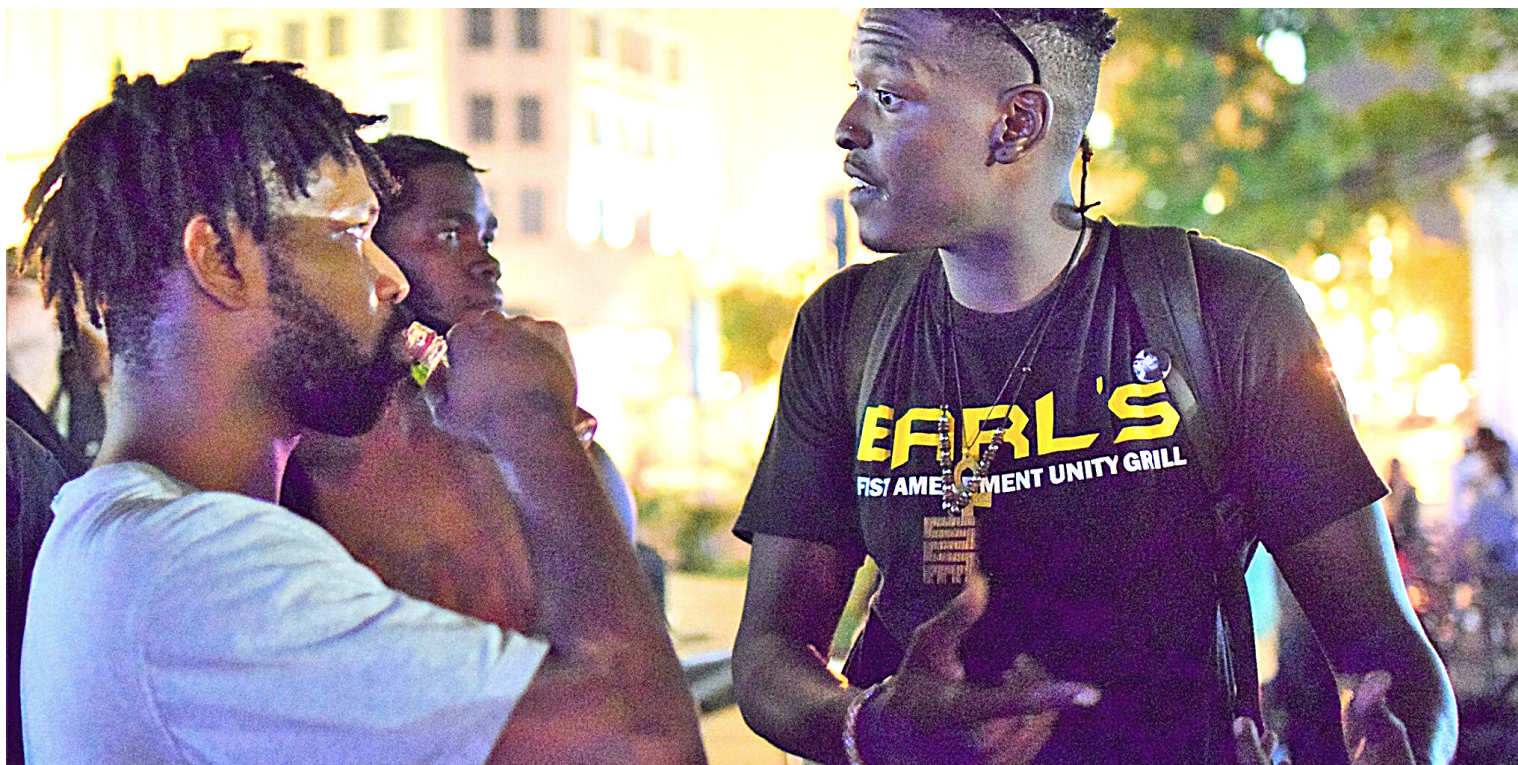
